CHAMPAGNE

Gruet, Selection Brut 12% ABV (Champagne, France) £65

Sophie Cossy, Cuvée Éclat 12.5% ABV (Champagne, France) £80 (VG)

This producer grows champagne harmoniously combining freshness and maturity. The bouquet opens with delicious fragrances of ripe fruit, honey and brioche.

WHITE WINE

With love from the Cape, Sauvignon Blanc 12.5% ABV (Western Cape, South Africa) £25 (VE)

Vibrant green grass and gooseberry aromas, broad palate with lively mineral finish.

With love from the Cape, Chenin Blanc 13.5% ABV (Western Cape, South Africa) £25 (VE)

Bright fruit flavours of pear, white peaches are the primary flavours on the palate, with hints of oatmeal and brioche on the finish which add intensity and mouthfeel.

Alegro, Rioja Blanco 12.5% ABV (Rioja, Spain) £26 (VE)

Green apple with lemon and lime citrus with honeydew melon, white peach and a rounded finish.

Cramele Recas, Pinot Grigio 11% ABV (Recas, Romania) £28 (VE)

From the award-winning winery this light-bodied wine bursts with fragrant aromas of ripe citrus fruits, green apples, and delicate floral notes.

Azevedo, Vinho Verde 12% ABV (Vinho Verde, Portugal) £32 (VE)

Vibrant, full-bodied, and crisp on the palate, aromas of fresh citrus fruit, ripe nectarine, lime blossom and fresh mango

Tenimenti, Gavi 12% ABV (Gavi, Italy) £32 (VG)

Pale gold colour with greenish tints. On the nose, it has a delicate bouquet with notes of vanilla and white flowers. This wine is dry, clean and elegant with an attractive, lingering aftertaste of fruits and spices.

Pattingham Vineyards, Nurton Brook Solaris 12.5% ABV (Staffordshire, England) £40 (VE)

A crisp, refreshing, fruity white wine which has notes of citrus and stone fruit on the palate.

Hubert Brochard, Sancerre 13% ABV (Sancerre, France) £60 (VE)

This exquisite Sauvignon Blanc showcases a pale golden colour and exudes aromas of citrus, green apple, and a hint of freshly cut grass.

Domaine Chanson, Chablis 12.5% ABV (Burgundy, France) £70 (VE)

Delicate floral fragrances mixed with citrus fruit on a subtle minerality. Tight and tense with a good structure. Refreshing mineral finish.

ROSÉ WINE

Le Wine. Rosé 12.5% ABV (VdF, France) £25 (VE)

Lovely salmon pink colour, red fruits on the nose with strawberry notes. This is a very pleasant wine with freshness and roundness.

Dom. de la Rouviere, Cotes de Provence Rosé 11% ABV (Provance, France) £35 (VE)

Aromas of red fruits and raspberries. Generous and fruity on the palate; volume, balance and length are combined to give it the utmost elegance.

Pattingham Vineyards, Moor Meadow Rosé 11% ABV (Staffordshire, England) £35 (VE)

This English blush is filled with soft summer fruits followed by a refreshing citrus finish.

RED WINE

With love from the Cape, Merlot 14% ABV (Western Cape, South Africa) £25 (VE)

A red wine for all occasions; a deep red colour with a nose full of plum, cherry and mouthwatering dark fruits. Lucious and smooth with silky tannins and a long dark cherry finish.

With love from the Cape, Cabernet Sauvignon 14% ABV (Western Cape, South Africa) £25 (VE)

Juicy, dark plum fruit flavours, a rich velvet mid palate and soft round tannins on the finish.

Alegro, Rioja Crianza 13% ABV (Rioja, Spain) £28 (VE)

A smooth Spanish Rioja with red fruit, vanilla, and hints of liquorice and toffee. Light-bodied with firm tannins and a balanced, elegant finish.

Finca Buenaventura, Origen Malbec 13.5% ABV (Mendoza, Argentina) £35 (VE)

A full-bodied wine with ripe black fruit flavours supported by cherries and juicy plums, there are also hints of violets and vanilla, great texture and a long finish.

Pattingham Vineyard, Great Moor Précoce Pinot Noir 13% ABV (Staffordshire, England) £40 (VE)

Great Moor is a delicate, fresh and fruity wine which has notes of redcurrant and raspberry with soft tannins.

Chateau Grand Peyrou, Saint Emilion Grand Cru 13% ABV (Bordeaux, France) £60

Immediately open and expressive on the nose with notes of blackcurrant, aniseed, graphite & cinnamon. The palate shows good structure and concentration. A fine example of a Bordeaux.

Folonari, Amarone della Valpolicella 15.5% ABV (Veneto, Italy) £70

Deep ruby red with a garnet rim, then a generous, complex nose with jam, raisin and violet notes, hints of spice and balsam, echoes of forest floor.
