Come Pulpo y Bebe Vino Albarino 2020, Spain (vg) £26

Very fresh and with aromas of apple, lime and lemon. Fresh on the palate too.

Zaccagnini Verdicchio dei Castelli di Jesi DOC 2021, Italy £26

Verdicchio is the most widely planted grape variety in Marche making it integral to the history of the land. It's crisp and dry with notes of citrus and a fresh, saline aroma.

Roberto Sarotto Gavi DOCG del Comune di Gavi 2022, Italy (vg) £32

Delicate floral blossom aromas with hints of pineapple, apricot and peach. The palate is fresh and vibrant, balanced with extra richness in texture from aging on the fine lees.

Chapel Down Bacchus 2022, England £36

The warm summer of 2013 shines through, giving intense aromas of grapefruit, gooseberries and freshly cut grass. Fresh, with green apple and nettle flavours leaving a clean, crisp finish.

Pouilly Fume 2021, France £40

Inviting pale lemon-gold, with subtle aromas of grass, fresh fennel and gunflint against a backdrop of citrus. A ripe grapefruit palate with refreshing, zesty acidity

Pouilly Fuisse Domaine Trouillet 2021, France £48

Complex, elegant Chardonnay with fresh aromas of almond and citrus, followed by ripe peach, brioche and honey.

red wines

Crescendo Merlot 2022, Italy £26

Intense ruby red and violet blue. Typical scents of merlot and hints of blackberry and cherry. Well defined notes of red berries, extraordinarily round and complex.

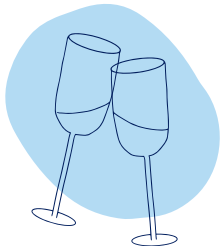
Leon Cornalines Red by Leon Perdigal, Cotes-du-Rhone 2022, France £26

Ruby with purplish highlights. It is complex, dominated by tart red berries on the nose. Fine tannic structure, well balanced by roundness and fruitiness. Very pleasant to drink.

Valpolicella Ripasso Superiore (organic) 2021, Italy £30

Made from fresh Corvina grapes, re-fermented with semi-dried ex-Amarone grape skins. The dried grapes add a touch of sweetness and body, making for this famously bold and flavourful style.





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red wines

Beronia Rioja Crianza, CZA Edicon Limitada 2019, Spain

£32

Attractive and intriguing on the nose, prominent aromas of red cherry fruit overlay a backdrop of cinnamon, cacao and spicy pepper tones. Hints of camomile and thyme bring an element of freshness

Bourgogne Pinot Noir, Cave de Lugny 2022, France (vg)

£34

Clear and shiny ruby red, with subtle aromas of red and black fruits and notes of warming spices. Medium body with notes of red fruits and liquorice, with a fresh and soft finish.

Chateau Meyney Bordeaux 2016, France

£48

This 92-point claret is made by Chateau Meyney, the only winery in Medoc that has clay soils similar to those at £2,500-per-bottle Petrus. It's a second wine in name, but made with the same care as the grand vin.

rosé

Coteaux D'Aix en Provence, Nicolas Rouzet 2021 France

£30

A pale, delicate rosé, fine and elegant with red berry notes. The palate is round and marked by strawberry, raspberry, blackcurrant, and a hint of peppery spice.

sparkling

Zarlino Prosecco DOCG, Italy (vg)

£26

The flavour is nicely balanced, with delicate fruity notes & low acidity.

Nicolas Feuillatte 'Grand Reserve' Brut Champagne, France

£42

Aged for at least 3 years in the winemakers cellar, slowly developing complex flavours and a rich texture.

Nyetimber Classic Cuvee, England

£48

A champagne-like nose of citrus fruit, brioche and shortbread. Elegantly shaped and supremely poised.
