Balfour, Liberty's Bacchus, England <i>Textured and complex, with flavours of elderflower, hedgerow and cedar wood and a spicy finish.</i>			58
Louis Jadot Chablis, Cellier du Valvan, Burgundy France <i>An elegant Chablis bursting with white flowers and stone fruits aromas. Round and subtle on the palate, this wine has a long finish with a stony character.</i>			67

Berri Estates, Shiraz, Australia <i>Packed with black cherries, plums and raspberries, the tannins are soft and the nose heady with sandalwood, vanilla and a hint of black pepper.</i>	7.95	15	30
Short Mile Bay, Merlot, Australia <i>A wonderful expression from south-eastern Australia with smooth tannins, a spicy nose of sandalwood and vanilla and notes of ripe plum, mulberry and blackberry on the palate.</i>	8.25	16	32

Zensa, Organic Primitivo, Italy <i>A complex bouquet, reminiscent of cherries, dried berries and toasted almonds. In the mouth it is full-bodied yet smooth and elegant with a silky texture. Fleurie, Chateau de Bellevue, France <i>Notes of redcurrant and raspberry are prominent in this single vineyard expression from a Cru in the centre of the Beaujolais region. With lovely length the finish is overlaid with strawberry blossom and a hint of stone.</i>			60
Terrazas de los Andes, Malbec, Argentina <i>Bright red in colour with purple shades, this wine has an intense floral and fruity aroma with notes of violets, black cherry and plum. Toast and spice come through, with hints of black pepper and chocolate.</i>	15.95	31	62
Black Angus, Cabernet Sauvignon, Australia <i>A powerful, full-bodied single-vineyard wine featuring intense notes of blackcurrant, plum, and cedar. With dense silky tannins, and savoury earthy undertones, this pairs wonderfully with red meats.</i>			70
Cocciapazza Montepulciano Organic, Torre dei Beati, Italy <i>A complex Montepulciano from organic vineyards in this famous coastal Italian region, with plums and chocolate on the palate and layers of spice, liquorice and tobacco on the nose.</i>			78
